*The Two + Two Articulation Agreement in Accounting* between the Accounting programs at Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College and Claflin University assures that students who successfully complete academic credit courses of study may transfer those courses with full credit between institutions. This Agreement will be reviewed for update on an annual basis.

The specifics of this Agreement are:

1. Students who complete an Associate in Business Degree with a major in Accounting at Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College can receive 60-semester transfer credit hours of course work toward a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Accounting at Claflin University. (See attached approved transfer curriculum).
2. Students at Claflin University who successfully complete academic courses of study on the approved curriculum agreement may transfer approved courses to Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College (See attached approved transfer curriculum).
3. Students should complete the specific courses outlined in the *Two + Two Accounting Articulation Agreement* at their original institution. (See attached approved transfer curriculum).
4. Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in any course eligible for transfer between institutions.
5. Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College students must request an official transcript to be sent to the Registrar at Claflin University together with the regular application for admission.
6. Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College students entering into the Baccalaureate Degree program at Claflin University will be subject to the requirements specified in the Claflin University catalog that is current at the time of their matriculation into the program.

The institutions must maintain required standards in accordance with the Commission on Higher Education (CHE) guidelines, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) accreditation standards, and/or the Association of Collegiate Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP) standards.

The institutions reserve the right to modify requirements. This agreement does not provide for a complete match of curricula at the two institutions. Thus, each institution and its authorized representatives agree to provide transferring students with relevant, current, and sound academic advice to prevent loss of legitimate credit hours or time in a student's attempt to secure a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Accounting at Clafin University after completing an Associate in Business Degree with a major in Accounting at Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College.
