Under the Admissions Policies of the South Carolina State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education, Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College may offer post-secondary education opportunity to secondary school students in its service area. The College will enroll students only under the following provisions:

1. The student must be classified as a junior or senior by the secondary school that he/she attends.
2. If the student's coursework at Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College involves use of on-campus shop or laboratory equipment, the student must be at least 16 years of age to enroll in the course.
3. The student must be granted permission to attend Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College by his/her high school principal and guidance counselor.
4. The student must meet all admission criteria for the courses(s) he/she desires to take.
5. The student will be considered a student of Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College while enrolled in the courses(s).
6. The College will work closely with the student, his/her secondary school, and counselor to obtain the maximum benefit from this experience.
