As of March 31, 2021

- (1.) Orangeburg- Calhoun Technical College (OCtech) signed and returned to the Department of Education the CARES Act Certification and Agreement. This document is an assurance that OCtech has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- (2.) The total amount of funds that the OCtech will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$998,323.
- (3.) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as March 31, 2021 is \$998,323.
- (4.) The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 1,837.
- (5.) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 1,399.
- (6.) OCtech's method of evaluating eligibility was based on the student being Title IV eligible and based off of the students enrollment status and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. - (7.) This constitutes OCtech's final report of CARES Act funding awarded to the College in support of Emergency Student Aid.
