# OFFICE OF ADMISSIONS EARLY COLLEGE PARENT/STUDENT AGREEMENT

#### PARENT DISCLOSURE

I understand that by allowing my child to participate in the Early College program, I will be responsible for following the guidelines and academic calendar of not only the high school, but also the college. I understand that students taking courses for dual credit are responsible for the cost of books and course fees unless otherwise directed by the high school.

I will be responsible for any costs not covered by Lottery Tuition Assistance and SC WINS for courses taken with Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College, which are due at the beginning of each semester. Students who remain in class after the end of the published add/drop period can withdraw only with the permission of their school advisor under the SC Uniform Grading Policy.

NOTE: Students enrolled in Early College courses are legally considered college students. Parents cannot unilaterally request information concerning the student from the instructor. Only school officials and students may legally make such a request. With a student's consent, a parent may be present at a conference with the instructor and the student.

### STUDENT AGREEMENT

To be successful, I must attend class and maintain communication with my instructors, high school counselor and the Early College Director. I understand that the amount of work necessary in these courses may be much greater than in high school courses. In addition, Early College courses become a part of my permanent college transcript. It is important to do well in these courses to realize all the benefits of the program. Early College students are treated the same as any other college student and are subject to all college polices governing students while attending classes offered by Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College.

I understand that by becoming an Early College student, I must abide by the high school's and college's rules and regulations. I also understand that grades, attendance and any other academic information will be provided to the high school as part of this agreement.
