Faculty are provided the opportunity for leadership through membership in institutional committees, through participation in division meetings and interview panels, and through involvement in the Faculty Organization. Faculty interests are represented on the College's strategic leadership team by the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

It is the policy of OCtech to place primary responsibility for the content, quality, and effectiveness of its curriculum with the faculty. The faculty shall exercise this responsibility through their active participation in division meetings and institutional committees, especially the Curriculum Committee. The Faculty Council chairman shall serve on the Curriculum Committee of the College.
