Under the Admissions Policies of the South Carolina State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education, Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College may offer postsecondary education opportunity to secondary school students in its service area. The College will enroll students only under the following provisions:

1. The student must be classified as a junior or senior by the secondary school that he/she attends.
2. The student must be granted permission to attend Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College by his/her parent/guardian and high school principal or school guidance counselor. If home schooled, the student must be granted permission to attend by his/her parent/guardian and the Home School Association.
3. The student must meet all admission criteria for the course(s) he/she desires to take.
4. The student will be considered a student of Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College while enrolled in the course(s).

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Any exception to the criteria must be approved by the College President.

The intent of this policy is to establish the opportunity to minimize geographic, financial, and scholastic barriers to post-secondary programs and services offered by Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College. The College in no way intends to compete with local school districts for the enrollment of students.
