Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College awards transfer credit to students who have completed acceptable coursework at any post-secondary institution that is accredited as degree granting by a post-secondary regional accrediting association at the time the coursework is completed.

Coursework that is transferred must closely parallel coursework offered by Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College and must be equivalent in semester hours. Coursework in which a grade of "C" or better is earned will be considered for transfer credit. Coursework completed over seven years may not be accepted for transfer credit. Appeals regarding transfer credit should be made in writing to the Assistant Vice President of Academic Affairs.

Applicants may transfer as much as 75% of the program requirements, but must complete a minimum of 25% of coursework at Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College.
