Pursuant to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College will provide "reasonable" course, program and testing accommodations for students with qualifying disabilities. However, special accommodations will not be provided for students if it is deemed that:

- 1) providing the accommodation would fundamentally alter the program of study, course or activity;
- 2) the accommodation being requested is not supported by the documentation;
- 3) providing the accommodation would pose a direct threat to the student or to others;  
and
- 4) providing the accommodation would constitute an undue administrative or financial burden to the institution.
