Students are recognized for the following academic honors each semester at Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College.

Dean's List – Each semester, full-time students who meet specified criteria are placed on the Dean's List. Criteria for the Dean's List includes: (1) minimum of 12 credit hours attempted and earned; (2) earn 100% of regular curriculum credit hours attempted and not be enrolled in any remedial classes that begin with a 0 course number; (3) meet or exceed a minimum grade point average of 3.5.

Part-Time Dean's List – Criteria for Part-time Dean's List includes: (1) the student must complete 6 -11.5 credit hours for the term; (2) the student must complete 100% of regular curriculum credit hours attempted and not be enrolled in any remedial classes that begin with a 0 course number; (3) the student must meet or exceed a term grade point average of 3.5.

President's List – Each semester, full-time students who meet specified criteria are placed on the President's List. Criteria for the President's List includes: (1) minimum of 12 credit hours attempted and earned; (2) earn 100% of regular curriculum credit hours attempted and not be enrolled in any remedial classes that begin with a 0 course number; (3) possess a grade point average of 4.0.

Part-Time President's List – Criteria for Part-time President's List includes: (1) the student must complete 6 -11.5 credit hours for the term; (2) the student must complete 100% of regular curriculum credit hours attempted and not be enrolled in any remedial classes that begin with a 0 course number; (3) the student must possess a term grade point average of 4.0.

Each semester, students receive a letter from the President or Vice President for Student Services. In addition, the names are published in local news media each semester.
